

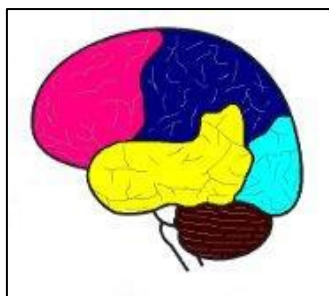

- Structured, sequential multi-sensory literacy programmes

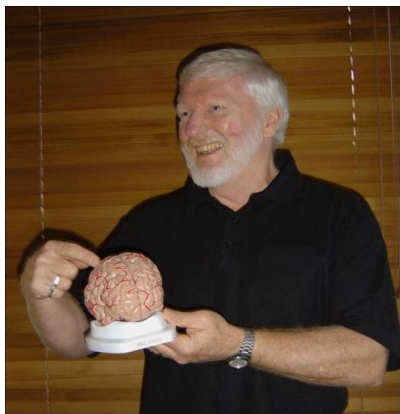

Mike Scaddan: mental skills facilitator, coach, professional developer, teacher, principal and current consultant for Education and Achievement Association Inc.

After completing a MEd in neuro, cognitive and behavioural science, Mike has guided the change by which many schools organise and deliver their teaching and thinking through a deep understanding of how learning happens.

Mike is convinced that thinking and learning programmes will not work to their potential until students understand and master their own thoughts and through this, their self-talk. This understanding, coupled with knowing how they learn best is essential in developing the confidence to take risks necessary for deep learning to occur. While this is important for all students it is vital for the success of those labelled as different learners.

Jenny Tebbutt is an educational consultant working alongside primary, secondary, post-secondary schools and organisations since 2000 to raise achievement in at risk groups within the education sector. Mike Scaddan Day 1 - The seminar will explore neuro cognitive and behaviour science and how it can assist to improve outcomes in the classroom. Much of what we want students to learn is based upon memories however, most of us as educators were not taught how to understand how memories can be imbedded and then retrieved. The workshop is totally practical and explores the important aspects of memory and how we can use strategies to effect learning and improve outcomes.

Jenny Tebbutt – Day 2 – The seminar will explore raising achievement for at risk student groups such as those with dyslexia, dyspraxia, ADHD etc. it will focus on teaching for diversity, differentiation, best policy and practice This seminar will also explore the importance of metacognitive teaching strategies in literacy to raise achievement. It will look at successful programmes and techniques for enhanced outcomes in reading and comprehension, spelling and writing. It will discuss assessment and how to use this information to inform teaching and learning.

Warren Shephard Day 3 – This seminar will focus on raising achievement in mathematics years 0-8. This session will explore key mathematical ideas that all students need to succeed in mathematics. Approaches to teaching these concepts will be shared along with activities to support students learning. The workshop will focus on teaching strategies to support students who are working below expectations in numeracy. An emphasis on the use of equipment in the teaching of place value, fractions, decimals and percentages.
