Workshop: 4D | Parent & Child - creating the connection

Staying connected to your child and their learning can be difficult when the challenges of dyslexia or other differences arise - especially when it comes to homework and learning for tests. Ensuring that your child knows that you understand and are willing to support them is critical for their self esteem and future opportunities as is actually knowing how and what to do. Focusing on aspects of reading for meaning, spelling tricky words and organising ideas on paper, this unique workshop teaches parents some of the "tricks of the trade" and gives them the opportunity to try them out on their children - while being supported by experienced teachers.

Workshop: 4D | Dyslexia Aware Best Practice - the new teaching paradigm

Participants in this course will already have a solid background of meeting the needs of dyslexic type learners with significant learning challenges. Phonic approaches, ITC solutions, assessment tools, and behaviour management will all be covered with a clear focus on small group interventions and strategies for students who have failed to respond to "notice and adjust" strategies in the classroom. This interactive and practical workshop will provide information and solutions that demonstrate exactly how you can help employees manifest their potential and add value to your business - from making bulletins and documents more accessible to policy that respects and empowers.

The 4D Inclusive Classroom - how to meet additional learning needs without affecting the education of the rest of the class.

This workshop builds on the 4D principle of "get it right for dyslexia and get it right for all" to show how fine tuning learning and teaching for students with AD(H)D, ASD, Dyspraxia/DCD, Speech and Language, Visual and Hearing issues and challenging behaviour may also improve the achievement and attainment of all. The key barriers to learning for these additional needs will be unpacked to demonstrate "barrier busting" practical solutions to support teachers to fine tuning current practice to include these vulnerable students - all in a context of the National curriculum and the National Standards.
